ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Village of Bayside will accept sealed Bids until 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday, March 9, 2010, at the office of the Village Clerk, Village of Bayside, 9075 North Regent Road, Bayside, Wisconsin 53217. At that time, Village officials will publicly open and read the Bids for the furnishing of all materials and the performance of the following work, in accordance with the Contract Documents (CD):

Rehabilitation of 23 Sanitary Sewer Manholes.

The anticipated Award Date is **March 18, 2010**. The selected Contractor may begin work only after the Village has issued him a Notice to Proceed. The preferred project start date is **July 16, 2010**. The selected Contractor must complete all work Not Later than 60 days after the date of issuance of the Notice to Proceed. This performance period does not include the in-pavement structure height adjustment work associated with the paving project

As a part of their Bid, Bidders shall submit a full and complete list of: 1) all of the proposed Subcontractors, 2) the class of work which each will perform, and 3) Contractor's Qualification Statement. Failure to include the Subcontractor list will be cause for rejection of a Bid. The selected Contractor shall not alter this list without the written consent of the Village Engineer. The CDs require that the selected Contractor furnish a Certificate of Insurance and Payment and Performance Bonds.

The selected Contractor and Subcontractor(s) must insure that they do not discriminate against any employees and/or applicants for employment because of race, creed, color, national origin, age, handicap, sex, physical condition, or developmental disability.

Bidders shall submit Bids on blanks prepared for that purpose and shall state prices in writing and in figures. Use the form contained in the CD. Bidders should pay particular attention to the requirements for Bid signatures, as set forth in paragraph 05 of the Instructions to Bidders. No Bidders may withdraw his Bid within the 90 day period after the date set for the opening of Bids.

The Village will only consider Bids from Bidders who accompany them with cash, a Bid Bond, or an unqualified certified check, payable to the Village of Bayside, in an amount equal to 5 percent of the Bid. This requirement serves to guarantee that, if the Village accepts the Bid, the selected Contractor will execute and deliver the proper Contract Agreement and Bonds within 15 calendar days from the date of award of the Contract by the Village Board. Failure to return these documents within this prescribed time will result in forfeiture, to the Village of Bayside, of the selected Contractor's cash, Bid Bond, or cashier's check, as liquidated damages.

Bidders may obtain copies of the CDs, beginning on **Tuesday, February 16, 2010** from Kapur & Associates, Inc., 7711 N. Port Washington Road, Glendale, Wisconsin 53217 for a deposit fee of \$35 per copy. Kapur will refund this deposit if the Bidder returns the CDs within seven calendar days of the Bid Opening. A Bidder desiring copies of the documents by mail must submit a separate, non-refundable \$10 check per copy for handling and mailing.

The Village Board of the Village of Bayside hereby reserves the right to accept the Bid most advantageous to it, to reject any or all Bids, and to waive any informalities in the process. The letting of the work described herein is subject to the provisions of Section 61.55 and 66.29, Wisconsin Statutes.
